

Report

COVID-19 posed a particular risk to patients with underlying issues such as heart disease, which is already the leading cause of death on the planet.



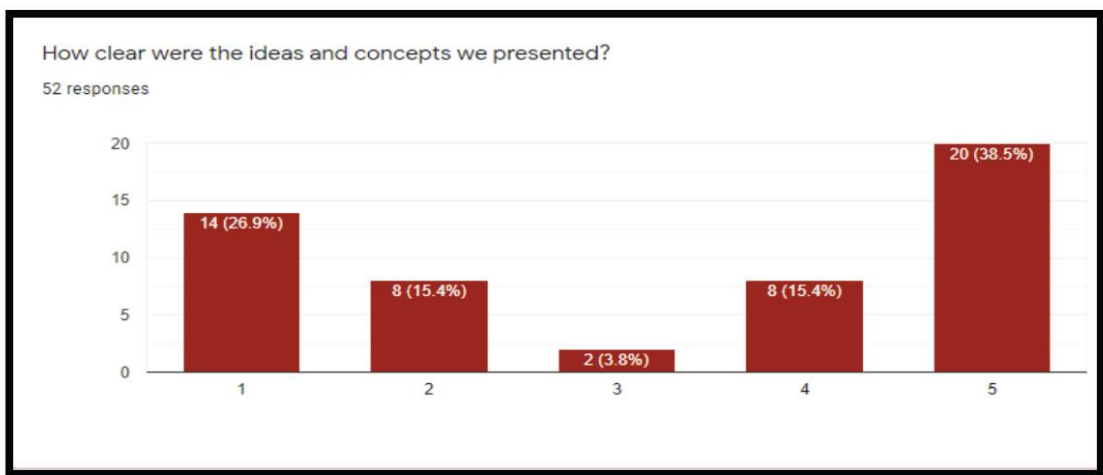

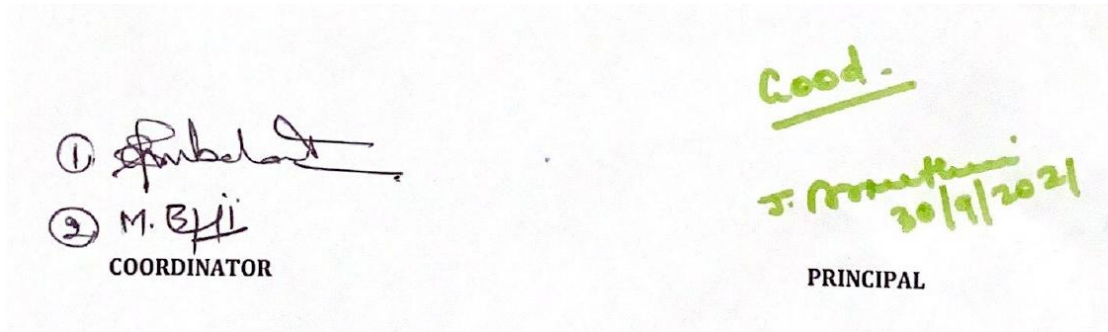

The multivariable analysis showed that monthly salary, occupational status, daily computer usage, history of previous eye problem, and knowledge on safety measures of **Computer Vision Syndrome (CVS)** and its adverse effect were found to be determinant factors for CVS.


The Webinar on Computer Vision Syndrome was organized at Kings College of Engineering through Google meet on 30.09.2021 at 11.00 am. The programme was started with the welcome address given by Mr.J.Radhakrishnan/AP-English. Our Secretary Dr. R. Rajendran inaugurated the Programme. The Principal Dr.J.Arputha Vijaya Selvi invigorated the organizers and student volunteers and our faculty members. The Programme was made by NSS programme officers Mr. P. Raajeshwaran, Unit I & Mr. S. Ambalatharasu, Unit II.


Our Resource person Dr. Swetha Ravichandran, M.B.B.S., D.O., Medical Officer, Aravind Eye Hospital from Pondicherry, delivered about **Computer Vision Syndrome (CVS)** are highly paid computer users and less likely to develop CVS than their low-paid counterparts. This might be due to the fact that high-paid computer users may have greater opportunity to use antiglare and good computers that could reduce the development of CVS. Conversely, low-paid ones were suffering from this disease because they could not afford these facilities. High-paid computer users might have good awareness on computer ergonomics and can optimize safe duration of computer exposure.

This demonstrated that the prevalence of CVS was found to be higher in government institutions; Monthly salary, daily exposure time, and knowledge were the most determinant factors for CVS. Hence, optimizing the exposure time and improving the awareness of users by rigorous training and management support are important to tackle the problem in the future. Finally the vote of thanks was delivered by our NSS programme officer Mr. S. Ambalatharasu, Unit II.


Report

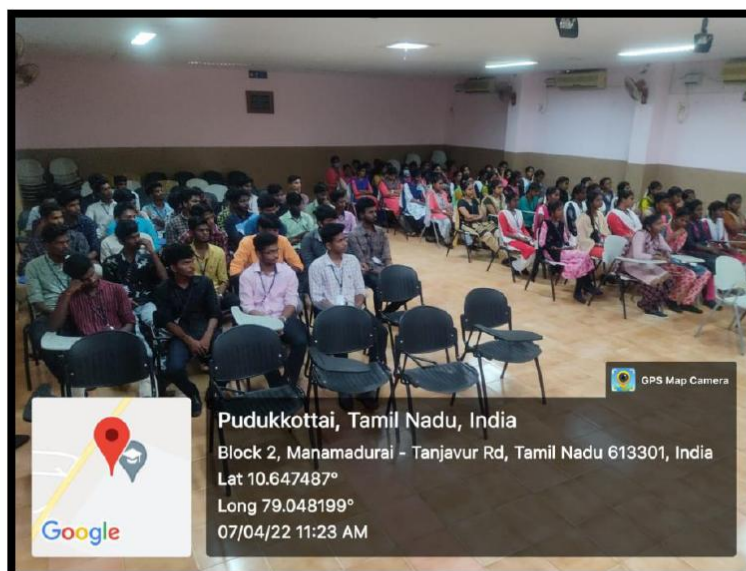
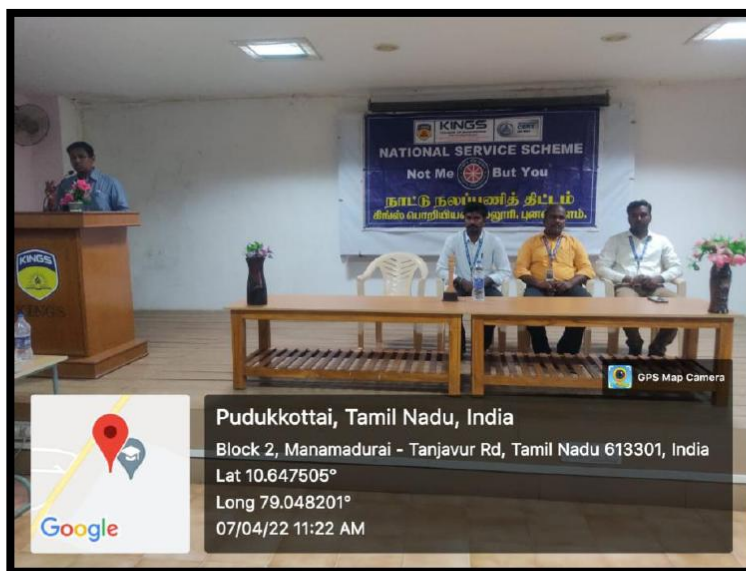
INAUGURAL SESSION

Pollution and plastics are found at the bottom of our deepest oceans, the highest mountains, and have made their way into our food chain. Systems that produce highly processed, unhealthy foods and beverages are driving a wave of obesity, increasing cancer and heart disease while generating a third of global greenhouse gas emissions.

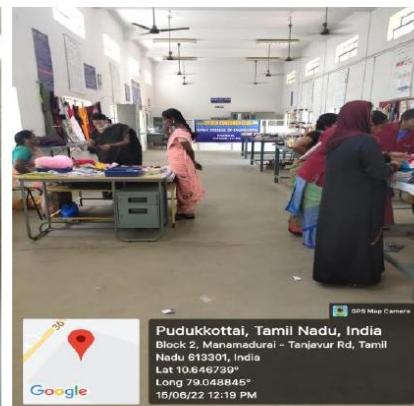

Richa Kar

Richa Kar is the founder of the well-known lingerie brand Zivame. As notable and acclaimed as the brand is now, Richa Kar's journey was a difficult climb to success. Born in Jamshedpur from a conventional background, Kar completed her education from the renowned BITS Pilani and pursued her Master's from Narsee Monji Institute of Management Studies, after which she worked in the IT sector.

Her idea of a lingerie brand was not welcomed by her parents who thought selling apparel online was embarrassing and people would make fun of their daughter's profession. However, against all the odds, she launched Zivame in 2011 using all her savings and a borrowed fund of INR 35 lakhs from her friends.

Through her hard work and determination, she impressed investors who started funding her project first with \$3 million in 2012, then \$6 million in 2013, and \$40 million in 2015. Today Zivame is worth more than \$6.81 Billion (681 crores).

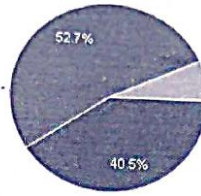

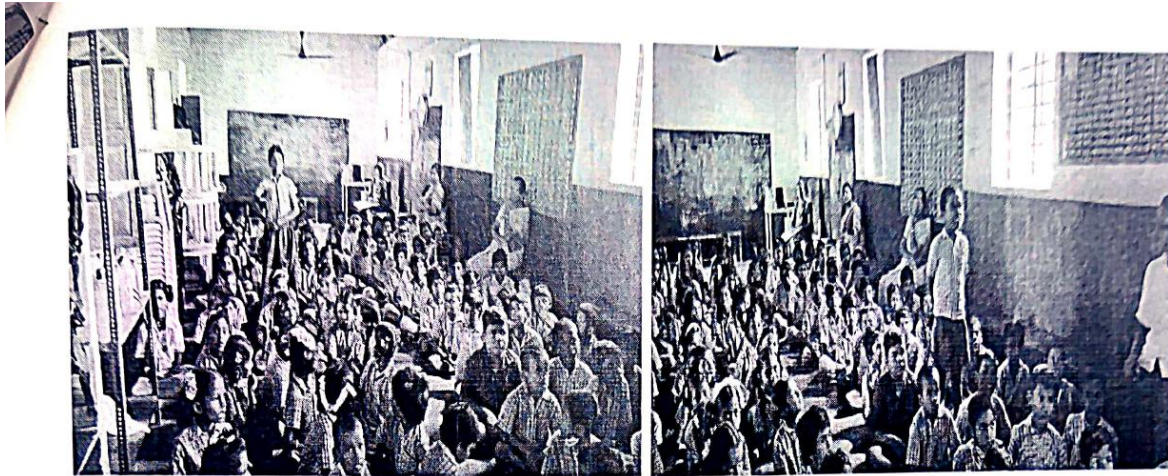
