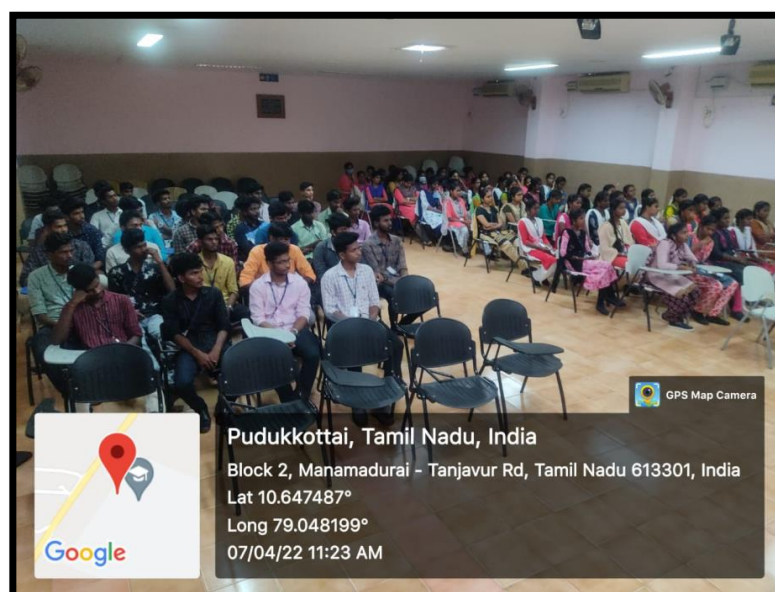
INAUGURAL SESSION

World Health Organization aims to focus global attention on the urgent actions needed to **“keep humans and the planet healthy”** and foster a movement **to create societies focused on well-being**. WHO estimates that more than 13 million deaths around the world each year are due to avoidable environmental causes. This includes the climate crisis which is the single biggest health threat facing humanity. The climate crisis is also a health crisis.

He also discussed about our political, social and commercial decisions are driving the climate and health crisis. Over 90% of people breathe unhealthy air resulting from burning of fossil fuels. A heating world is seeing mosquitos spread diseases farther and faster than ever before. Extreme weather events, land degradation and water scarcity are displacing people and affecting their health. Pollution and plastics are found at the bottom of our deepest oceans, the highest mountains, and have made their way into our food chain. Systems that produce highly processed, unhealthy foods and beverages are driving a wave of obesity, increasing cancer and heart disease while generating a third of global greenhouse gas emissions.

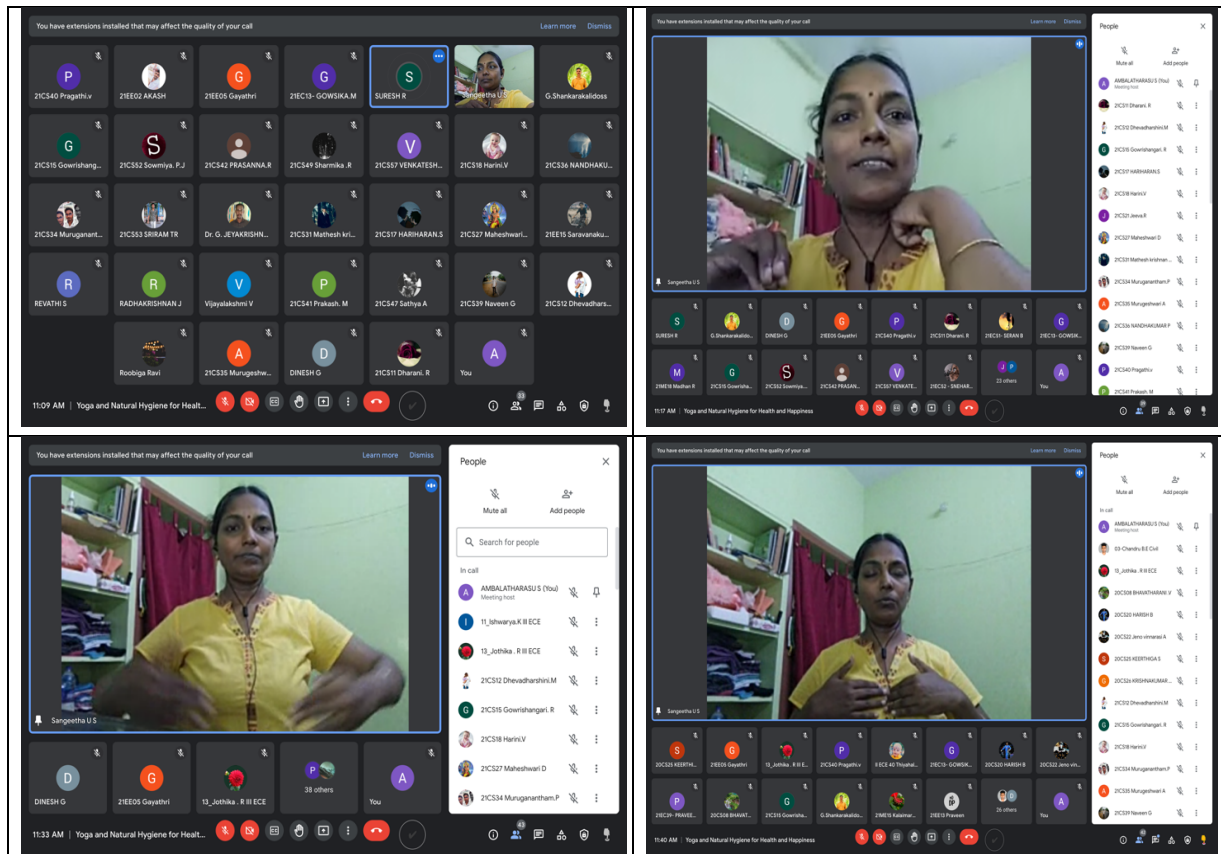

AN EVERYDAY HEALTH INFOGRAM

7 STEPS TO A HEALTHIER HEART


You don't have to make big changes to reduce your heart attack and stroke risk. Here are 7 healthy habits that could save your life.



1. **Live smoke-free.** If you smoke, quit.
2. **Monitor your blood pressure.** Keep your numbers below 120/80 mm Hg.
3. **Maintain a healthy weight.** Target a body mass index (BMI) of less than 25.
4. **Watch your cholesterol.** Strive for a total cholesterol less than 200 mg/dL.
5. **Control your blood sugar.** Aim for a fasting blood glucose less than 100 mg/dL.
6. **Get active.** Log 150 minutes of moderate-intensity activity - like brisk walking - per week (or 75 minutes of vigorous-intensity activity).
7. **Eat a heart-healthy diet.** Make vegetables and fruits, whole grains, and fish mealtime staples. Limit sodium, saturated fat, and added sugar.



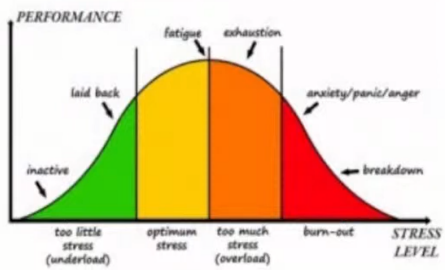

STRESS CURVE



The graph plots PERFORMANCE on the y-axis and STRESS LEVEL on the x-axis. The curve starts at 'inactive' (too little stress/underload), rises through 'laid back' to a peak at 'optimum stress'. Beyond the peak, it declines through 'fatigue' and 'exhaustion' to 'anxiety/panic/anger' (too much stress/overload), and finally drops to 'burn-out' and 'breakdown'.
