





#### Motivational Programme on "What to Do... & When to Do..."








One of the student greets the guest with a momento

As per the direction of Ministry of Youths Affairs and Sports in the scheme of Swach Pakhwada under Swachh Bharat Mission, a one day Programme on **WATER MANAGEMENT** was organized by the National Service Scheme Units of our college on 22.03.2021 at 05:00p.m. The programme officers Mr. P. Raajeshwaran, Unit I and Mr. S. Ambalatharasu, Unit II, had arranged this programme.

The Secretary Dr. R. Rajendran, and the Principal, Dr. J. Arputha Vijayaselvi, graced the inaugural function of this programme. The programme was formally started with a warm welcome by Mr. P. Raajeshwaran, In-charge of Unit I, Assistant Professor, English. About 180 volunteers of NSS Units enthusiastically were present online.

The Resource Person Mr.R.Sundaram, Assistant Professor, Civil Department, KCE, addressed ecologically that water is essential for our survival. He also noted, "One of the biggest concerns for our water-based resources in the future is the sustainability of the current and future water resource allocation. Water is an essential resource for all life on the planet. Two-thirds of the freshwater is locked up in ice caps and glaciers. Of the remaining one percent, a fifth is in remote, inaccessible areas and much seasonal rainfall in monsoonal deluges and floods cannot easily be used. Agriculture practices in this region have been identified as a major contributor to nutrient loading of receiving waters; Studies indicate that a person needs a minimum of 20 to 40 liters of water per day for drinking and sanitation. More than one billion people worldwide have no access to clean water."

The programme came to an end with vote of thanks delivered by Mr. S. Ambalatharast, In-charge of Unit II, Assistant Professor, Physics, KCE.

### Report

Every product has a shelf life, but sadly that is not the case with plastics. The fact is that our planet cannot digest plastic. Plastics take around 500 to 1000 years to completely degrade due to the presence of complex polymers. As a result, till now whatever bit of plastic has ever been manufactured or used by us can be found in some form or the other on the planet.

Insisting this idea, a one day Plastic Ban Awareness Programme was organized by the National Service Scheme in our college on 01.02.2019. The programme officers Mr. P. Rajeshwaran, Unit I, and Mr. S. Ambalatharasu, Unit II, had made all the arrangements for the programme.

The Programme was formally inaugurated by our Secretary, Dr. R. Rajendran, and the Principal, Dr. J. Arputha Vijaya Selvi. The programme witnessed the enthusiastic participation of 45 NSS volunteers. A power point presentation was presented by NSS PO to NSS volunteers in order to gain knowledge about the judicious use of plastic.

Tamil Nadu has made an announcement to ban the manufacture, sale, storage, and use of disposable plastic from January 1, 2019. The ban primarily covers the use of plastic carry bags, plastic plates, plastic cups, plastic flags, small plastic sachets used in packaging water, among others. Exclusions, however, apply for milk, curd, oil, and medicine packaging.

The awareness programme was really conducive to keep the environment clean and avoid using the plastics; our NSS volunteers stuck inside the campus the slogans of plastics ban usage. More than 700 pupils were given awareness through the programme. The programme also disseminated a note of awareness to the volunteers who has undiminished concern for the society.




