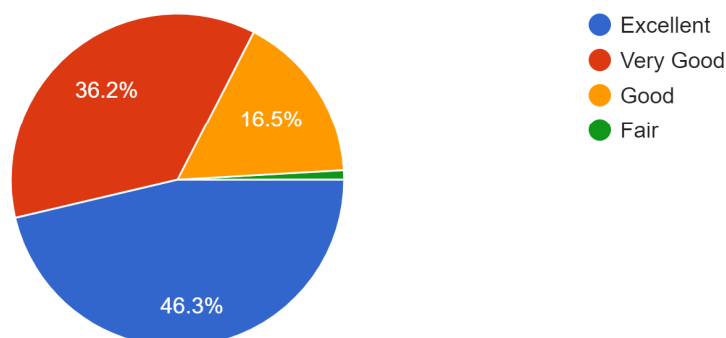
#### Content of the Program?

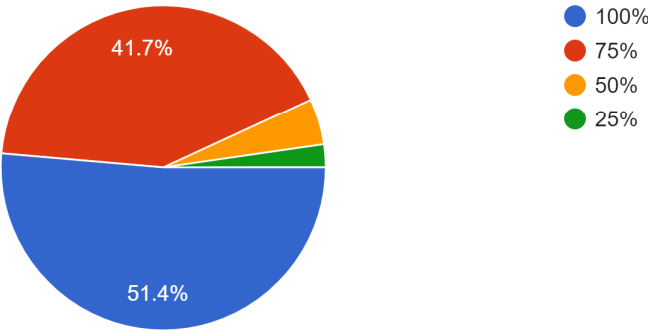
#### Speaker's way of Presentation?

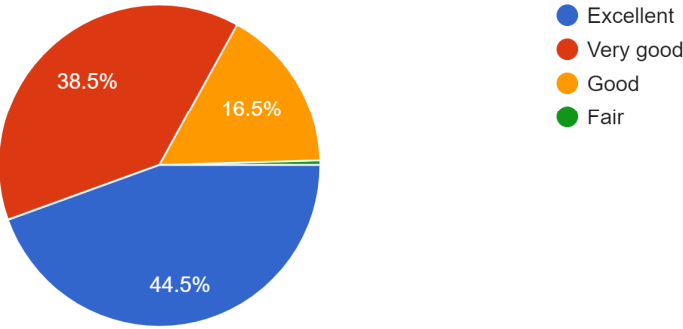

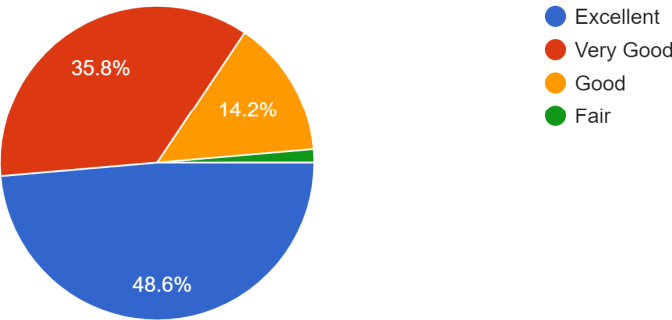
